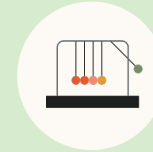




Introducing Recruiter System Connect

LinkedIn Recruiter System Connect (RSC) integrates LinkedIn Recruiter with your Mercury xRM account to make your hiring process even simpler. By turning on RSC, you're authorizing the sharing of candidate, job, and application data across Recruiter and Mercury xRM. It enables you to get up-to-date candidate information, boost collaboration, and access more applicant data in Recruiter and your ATS. 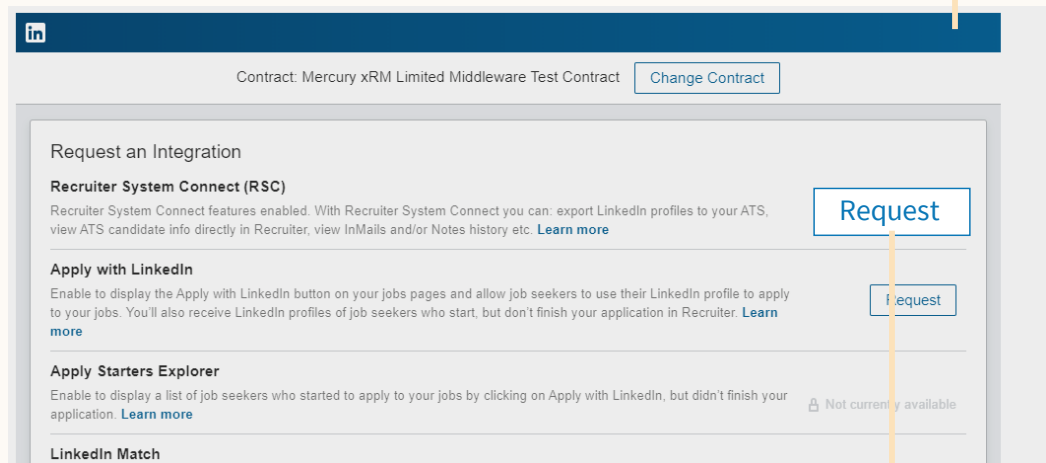
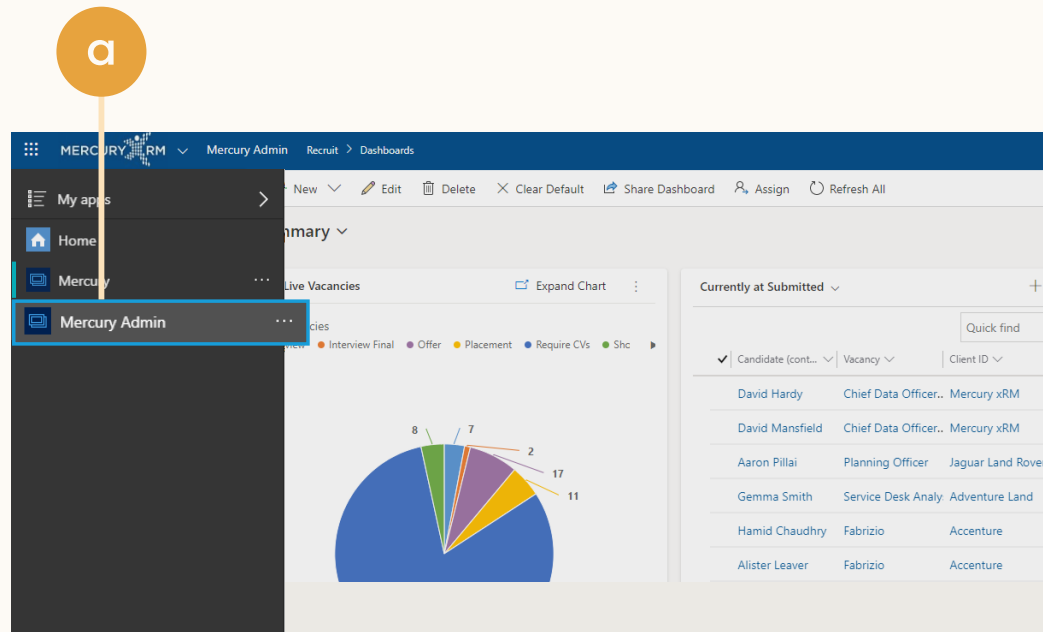

Step 1

Activate RSC in Mercury xRM.

- a Select **“Mercury Admin”** under the **“Dynamics 365”** dropdown menu
- b This will take you to the onboarding page and direct you to **“Request an integration”**
- c Click the **“Request”** button for Recruiter System Connect (RSC)

Once the request has been confirmed, the button will show as **“Partner ready”** and the confirmation message will direct you to continue on to LinkedIn Recruiter.



Step 2 Connect LinkedIn Recruiter to Mercury xRM.

- a Click on your profile image in the top-right corner
- b Select **“Product settings”** from the dropdown menu
- c Click **“ATS integration”** on the left side of the screen
- d Scroll to the Mercury xRM section
- e Choose to connect either Contract Level Access, Company Level Access, or both by selecting **“On”** for the desired access

For details on what each of these access levels means, click the **“Learn more about RSC”** link in LinkedIn Recruiter.

Note: Admins must enable Contract Level Access from their specific dashboard (if you have multiple LinkedIn Recruiter dashboards).
