

Share Jobs on LinkedIn

Search for the Job on LinkedIn and Share it with Your Network

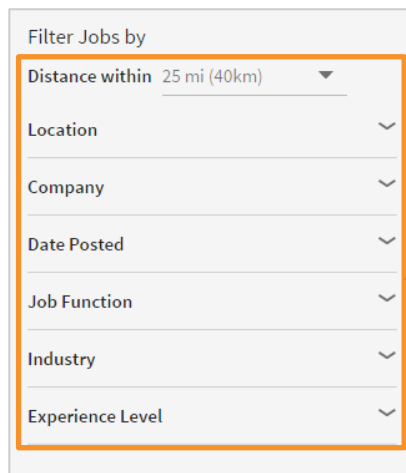
1. Sign in to LinkedIn.
2. Click the **Jobs** icon.



3. Search by job title, keywords, or company.
4. Enter a location by using city, state, postal code or country.

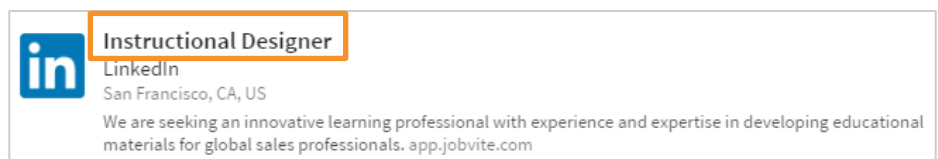


5. Use the filters on the right to find your job.

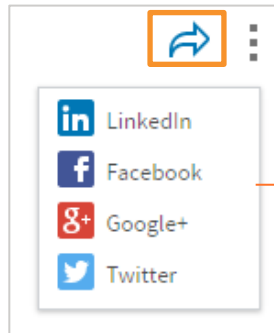


Narrow your results quickly using these additional filters.

How a Shared Job Appears in the Newsfeed

When you share a job on LinkedIn, your network can see the job in their newsfeed on their LinkedIn homepage. If a job at your organization has been shared on LinkedIn and you want to increase the visibility of the job, simply click **Share** from your newsfeed or click the job title to view the complete job posting and then share the job with your network.
