

## Overview

LinkedIn Learning is a paid content provider of premium business, technology, and creative skills courses. The integration with Degreed supports SSO and content integration. Enterprise completion integration is not currently supported but expected sometime during the first half of 2018. LinkedIn Learning content is not currently available in the external catalog, but can be configured as a Featured Provider in the internal org catalog.

## Implementation and Operation

The following table summarizes key elements of a typical implementation. While timelines and engagement may vary based upon your specific circumstances, this serves as a guide for setting reasonable expectations.

<b>Who leads integration</b>	Degreed Technical Implementation Consultant
<b>Client responsibility</b>	Complete Client Questionnaire; gather provider tech details
<b>Client IT engagement required</b>	None to limited
<b>Effort to implement</b>	2 weeks (work prioritization must be considered)
<b>Catalog integration frequency</b>	Runs nightly
<b>Completion integration frequency</b>	NA
<b>Catalog deletion processing</b>	When LinkedIn disables a course, the corresponding entry is automatically made obsolete in Degreed. Courses are removed from browse and search, but remain in pathways until removed by the client.
