

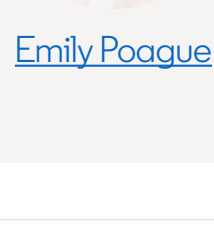

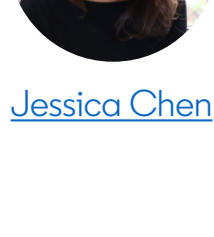

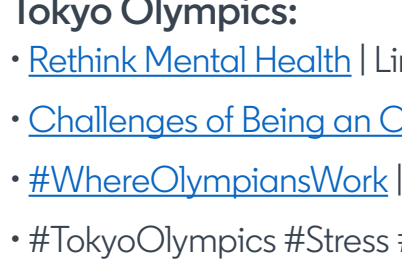
I'm most energized when ...

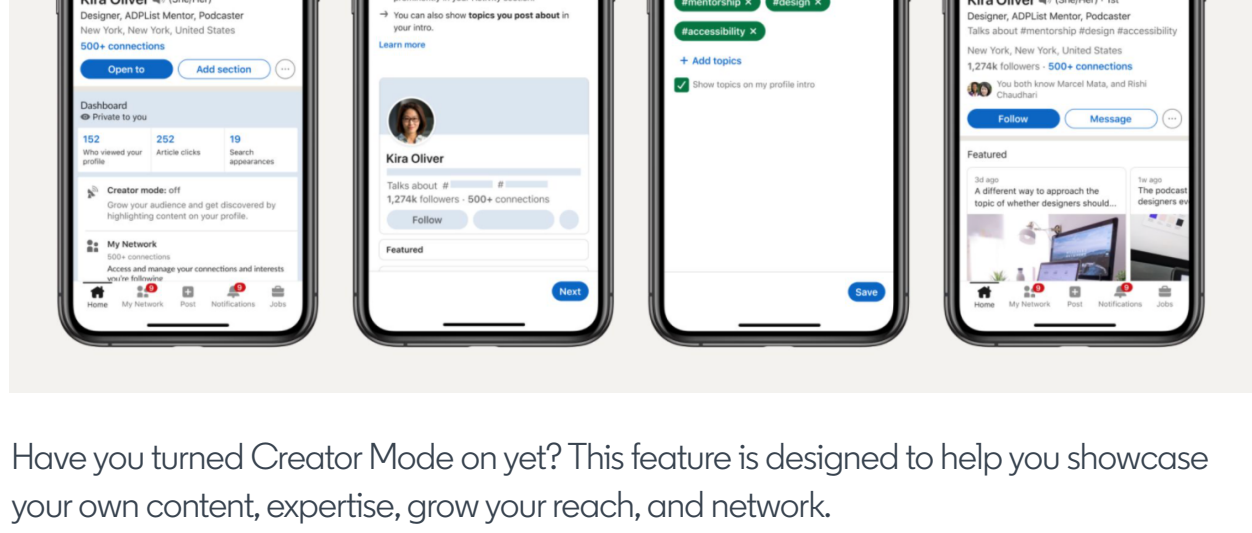
Upcoming changes to LinkedIn Live

We are making it easier for you to schedule and host your live event. Here are the changes planned over the next few months:

- **Scheduling a live stream will automatically create a LinkedIn Event.** When you create a Scheduled Live post from Streamyard, it will automatically show up on the feed as a new LinkedIn Event post. This means no more fishing for the broadcast url link.
- **You will be able to schedule a live stream more than 7 days in advance.** To give you more flexibility and gather a larger audience for your Scheduled Live event, we will remove the limit on how early you can schedule your live event.
- **Event page will only require 1 image upload.** New, customized banners are being created for each instructor.

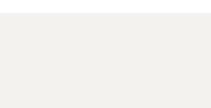
